

JCR Registration Requirements

A registrant shall satisfy the following condition 1) or 2) in order to register in the JCR.

- 1) If a registrant graduated from a CCE accredited or equivalent college, the person shall fall under any of the following:

- Graduated from a CCE accredited or equivalent college in or before February 2011.
- Graduated from a CCE accredited or equivalent college after February, 2011 with passing of the JCR-IBCE Registration Exam.
- Graduated from a CCE accredited or equivalent college after February 2011 with holding a national/ state/ province license in a regulated country.
- Graduated from a CCE accredited or equivalent college after February 2011 with passing of the NBCE (National Board of Chiropractic Examiners) Part I and Part II.

- JCR administers a registration exam with the assistance of the International Board of Chiropractic Examiners (IBCE).

- 2) If a registrant graduated from a JAC (Japanese Association of Chiropractors) -approved interim education program, the person shall fall under any of the following:

- Completion of a JAC-approved CSC program by 2008.
- Completion of a JAC-approved CSC program from 2009 to 2012 with passing of the JCR-IBCE Registration Exam.
- Completion of the JAC-approved Safety Training Program requested by the National Consumer Affairs Center of Japan with passing of the JCR-IBCE Registration Exam.

- CSC (Chiropractic Standardization Course) is a conversion program affiliated with a CCE accredited school. All four JAC-approve CSC programs ended in 2012.
- Safety Training Program for substandard practitioners started in 2014 with the request of the National Consumer Affairs Center of Japan.

Registration Procedure

1. Please ensure that you have met all registration requirements.

- Please check the 'registration requirements' on the back of the page.



2. Fill in the application form for JCR registration, 'Chiropractor Registration Form'.

- A photo of the chiropractor registration form is your ID photo (40mm×30mm) .



3. Send 'Chiropractor Registration Form' to the JCR administrative office attached with a copy of your chiropractic degree (diploma) and at least one of the following; a certificate providing you have passed the JCR Registration Exam or the NBCE Exam Parts I & II, or a copy of an overseas license/ registration to practice chiropractic.

Both graduates from a CCE accredited program before March 2011 and graduates from a JAC- approved CSC program before 2009, are exempted from the JCR Exam.

4. After we receive your fully completed application, we will send you an invoice for the registration fee of 10,000 Yen.

- No additional fee is charged for renewing your registration.



5. After you pay the registration fee, your personal details including 'Your Name (English and Japanese)', 'Registration Number', 'Prefecture (state) Area' and 'Office website' (optional) will be listed on the JCR database. The list of all JCR registrants will be submitted to the Japanese Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare every year.
